STEWART ISLAND

1 Ulva Island Birds & Forest

Hike through coastal rainforest and regenerating, inland native forest with towering podocarp trees, ferns, mosses and orchids. View native birds and look for Kiwi! Walk along shell laden beaches. Stay in huts, carry only daypacks - gear transported each day.
